## **BROTHERLY LIFE IN COMMUNITY** (BLF)

(Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and the Societies of Apostolic Life 1994)

- The ultimate fundament of brotherly life in community is supernatural
- A principle: "being a religious is fully realized through the community" (BLF, 25).
- The coming of liberalism.
